The Bottom Line: There Is No Other Gospel Than Salvation by Through in Christ!
Turning away (VS 6) Metatithēmi (Strong's G3346) to transpose (two things, one of which is put in place of the other) to fall away or from one person or thing to another
Accursed (VS 8-9) Anathema (Strong's G331) a thing devoted to God without hope of being redeemed, and if an animal, to be slain; therefore a person or thing to destruction 1. a curse 2. a man accursed, devoted to the direst of woes
The pursuit of human approval will eventually, if not immediately, commitment to Christ. (VS 10)
The is not a religion formed in the mind of man. It is the divine purpose of God the Father, unveiled through the life, death, and resurrection of Christ to those who will believe. (VS 11-12)
God weaves all of our life experiences, both the triumphs and tragedy, into His for His (VS 15-16)
Each of us is fashioned with a A divine design which not only brings God glory but satisfies our deepest desires. (VS 15-16)
