### The Bottom Line:

His \_\_\_\_\_ Is The Point.... Don't Forget It!

Never let a new trial return you to your \_\_\_\_\_.

In Christ, there is neither \_\_\_\_\_ nor \_\_\_\_\_ separation. There are only sons and daughters of God, heirs to His Kingdom.
